Index methodology

- Removes all companies classified as financials
- Selects the largest 50 companies, based in market capitalization, that are not currently in the Nasdaq-100 Index

Average Price/Earnings (P/E) Ratio is the current share price of a stock divided by its earnings per share. Market capitalization is the total dollar

Net asset value or NAV is a fund's total assets minus its total liabilities, divided by the number of outstanding shares. Premium/discount % indicates whether an ETF is currently trading at a higher or lower price than the current value of the securities in that portfolio.

The NASDAQ Q-50 Index is a market-capitalization weighted index designed to track the performance of companies that are next-eligible for inclusion into the NASDAQ-100 Index. The Index is comprised of 50 securities ranked by market capitalization and reflects companies across major industry groups, except financial companies. The S&P 500® Index is a market-capitalization-weighted index that measures the performance of the common stocks of 500 leading U.S. companies.

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
