(VCM) is a diversified global investment adviser registered under the Investment Advisers Act of 1940 and comprises multiple investment franchises: Integrity Asset Management, Munder Capital Management, New Energy Capital Partners, NewBridge Asset Management, Pioneer Investments, RS Investments, Sophus Capital, Sycamore Capital, THB Asset Management, Trivalent Investments, Victory Income Investors, and the Victory Capital Solutions Platform. RS Investments and Sophus Capital became a part of the VCM GIPS firm effective January 1, 2017; Victory Income Investors, effective July 1, 2019; THB Asset Management, effective March 1, 2021; New Energy Capital effective November 1, 2021; and Amundi Asset Management US, Inc. (renamed to "Pioneer Investments"), effective April 1, 2025.
- 3. The Trivalent International Emerging Markets Equity Composite includes all fee paying, non-wrap discretionary portfolios of \$100,000 or more that are managed according to the Trivalent International Emerging Markets Equity strategy. The strategy focuses on foreign companies that are characterized by improving business momentum and attractive valuations. Prior to October 2012, the minimum size for inclusion in the composite was \$1 million. The composite creation date is August 2011, and the composite inception date is September 2011.
- 4. The benchmark of the composite is the MSCI Emerging Markets Index (Net). The MSCI Emerging Markets Index (Net) captures large and mid cap representation across 24 Emerging Markets (EM) countries. With 1,151 constituents, the index covers approximately 85% of the free float-adjusted market capitalization in each country. The benchmark returns are provided to represent the investment environment existing during the time periods shown and are not covered by the report of independent verifiers. For comparison purposes, the index is fully invested, which includes the reinvestment of income. The returns have been taken from a published source and do not include any transaction fees, management fees, or other costs.
- 5. The internal dispersion of annual returns is measured by the standard deviation of asset-weighted gross returns of accounts included in the composite for the full year. If less than six portfolios are included in the composite for the full year, no dispersion measure is presented, as it is not considered meaningful (N/M). The three-year annualized ex-post standard deviation measures the variability of the composite's gross returns, and the benchmark returns over the preceding 36-month period. It is not required to be presented for annual when a full three years of composite performance is not yet available.

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6. Composite and benchmark returns are presented net of non-reclaimable withholding taxes. Gross-of-fees returns are presented before management and custodial fees but after all trading expenses. Net-of-fees returns are calculated by deducting 1/12 of the highest tier of the standard fee schedule in effect for the period noted (the model fee). The composite model fee for each period is either the highest tier of the current fee schedule or a higher value, whichever is required to ensure the model composite net-of-fee return is lower than or equal to the composite net-of-fee return calculated using actual fees. Actual fees may vary depending on, among other things, the applicable fee schedule and portfolio size. Prior to November 2014, net returns for this composite were calculated using actual management fees. The complete fee schedule for this product is:
