### INVESTMENT STRATEGY

At least 80% of the value of the Fund's net assets is normally invested in different kinds of investment grade debt securities, such as corporate bonds, mortgage-backed and asset-backed securities, zero-coupon bonds and obligations of the U.S. government and its agencies.

The Fund's investments are allocated among the various sectors of the debt markets by analyzing overall economic conditions within and among these sectors.

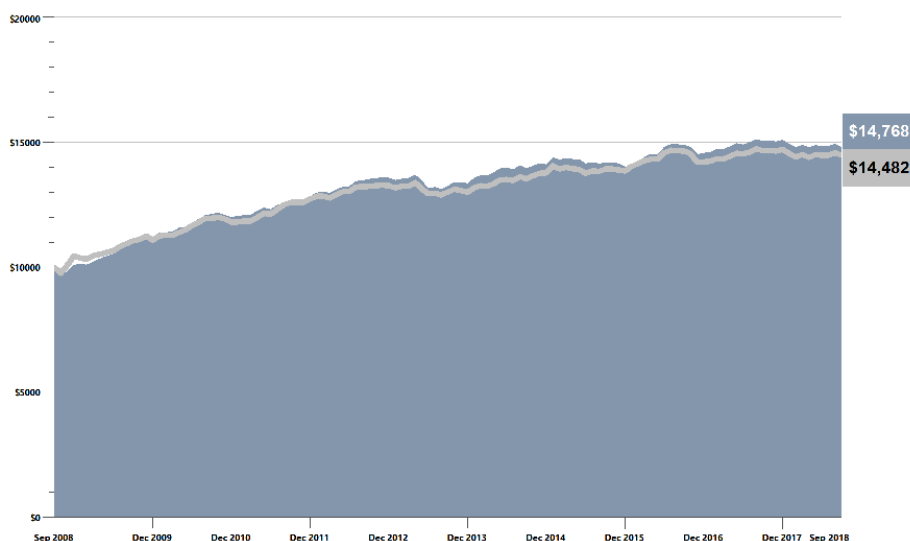

\*The Adviser has contractually agreed to waive its management fee and/or reimburse expenses through at least July 29, 2018 so that the total annual fund operating expenses after fee waiver and expense reimbursement (excluding acquired fund fees and expenses and certain other items such as dividend and interest expenses on short sales, interest, taxes and brokerage commissions) do not exceed 0.90%, 1.77%, 1.30% and 0.66% of the Fund's Class A, Class C, Class R and Class Y shares, respectively. The Adviser is permitted to recoup advisory fees waived and expenses reimbursed by it for up to three years after the fiscal year in which the waiver or reimbursement took place, subject to the lesser of any operating expense limits in effect at the time of the original waiver or expense reimbursement and at the time of recoupment or reimbursement. This agreement may only be terminated by the Fund's Board of Trustees. Please see the prospectus for details.

Risks Associated with Investing in the Fund: There is no guarantee that the Fund will achieve its objective. The return of principal in bond funds is not guaranteed. The principal value of a bond falls when interest rates rise and rises when interest rates fall. During periods of rising interest rates, the value of a bond investment is at greater risk than during periods of stable or falling rates. Benchmark: The Bloomberg Barclays U.S. Aggregate Bond Index is generally considered to be representative of U.S. bond market activity. The Bloomberg Barclays U.S. Aggregate Bond Index is an unmanaged index that is not available for direct investment and there are no expenses associated with the index while there are expenses associated with the Fund.

Characteristics Defined: Source: Victory Capital Management Inc. Fixed Income Team. Average Life: The weighted average life (WAL) or number of years for which each dollar of unpaid principal on a loan or mortgage remains outstanding. Once calculated, WAL tells how many years it will take to pay half of the outstanding principal. Duration: A weighted average of the maturity of all the income streams from a bond or portfolio of bonds. Generally, the higher the duration, the more sensitive the bond or bond portfolio to changes in interest rates.

Yield: A standard yield calculation developed by the SEC for bond funds. The yield is calculated by dividing the net investment income per share earned during the 30-day period by the maximum offering price per share on the last day of the period. The yield figure reflects the dividends and interest earned during the 30-day period, after the deduction of the fund's expenses. It is sometimes referred to as "SEC 30-Day Yield" or "standardized yield". Subsidized 30-Day SEC Yield is based on a 30-day period ending on the last day of the previous month and is computed by dividing the net investment income per share earned during the period by the maximum offering price per share on the last day of the period. If the fund expenses have waivers, the subsidized yield is based on the net expenses. Unsubsidized 30-Day SEC Yield is based on total expenses of the fund.

Credit Quality Ratings: Credit quality ratings are obtained using Bloomberg Barclays methodology using ratings derived from Moody's Investors Service (Moody's), Standard & Poor's (S&P) and Fitch Ratings (Fitch). When ratings from all three agencies are available, the median rating is used. When ratings are available from two of the agencies, the lower rating is used. When one rating is available, that rating is used. Victory Capital Management does not evaluate these ratings, but simply assigns them to the appropriate credit quality category as determined by the rating agency.

Fund Holdings and Duration Schedule: Fund holdings and duration are as of quarter end and may change at any time.
